

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS ON 7TH APRIL, 2019

On Sunday, April 7, 2019, Bratislava will host the largest running event organized in Slovakia - ČSOB Bratislava Marathon 2019 - for the 14th time already. More than 13,000 athletes from over 60 countries around the world will participate in the event. The royal discipline - marathon, expected to be attended by more than 7,000 runners, will require some traffic restrictions, however.

We would like to ask you for your understanding and patience, especially in Ružinov and the Old Town, on Sunday, April 7, 2019, from 9:00 am. to 1 pm, as we want to ensure the safety of the participants. The Šafárik Square and the Danube embankment will be impassable, so we recommend drivers using the bridges over the Danube (except Apollo Most) and the Petržalka bypass instead of crossing the city center along the Danube and Vajanské embankment. Entry to the city center is only possible for the residents of the zone and public transportation and only via Grosslingova and Medená streets. From the River Park, the closest you can get to the city center is the SNP Bridge. To exit the pedestrian zone of the city center use Palackého and Jesenského streets towards Dunajská Street.

All information about redirected public transport lines is to be found at www.dpb.sk. A special non-stop line - 0904 404 638 was created just for the event. If you are interested in information about the current status of the restrictions, please, do not hesitate and use it.
